Program Criteria

- * Eligibility based on maximum gross income criteria
- * Funds Issued in form of grants
- * Program Administered by Department of Energy and state/local agencies
- * Changes under American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009

- * Air sealing to reduce infiltration
- * Attic Insulation
- * Sidewall Insulation
- * Floor Insulation
- * Pipe and/or duct insulation
- * Limited Energy Related Repairs
- * Heating and Safety Evaluation
