LOCATIONS: They deliver customized care to six senior housing communities in Moorehead, MN; Pelican Rapids, MN; Detroit Lake, MN; and New York Mills, MN.

SERVICES: Services include housekeeping, laundry, meal preparation, meal reminders, medicine administration, medicine reminders, well checks, incontinence care, grooming, hygiene and bathing assistance, skin care, incidental nursing and several non-medical services.

Since 1996, LifeSTEPS' professional social services staff has provided a wide variety of programs and services depending on the needs of seniors or multifamily communities. Services meet all state and federal social service requirements for affordable housing communities.

LOCATIONS: Throughout the state of California LifeSteps services several hundred communities: they have 20 properties in the Bay Area; 27 in Central California; 51 in the Desert Region; 29 in South Bay; 50 in southern Los Angeles; 39 in the Valley and 51 in Sacramento.

SERVICES: LifeSteps' Case Management program offers medical equipment, understanding healthcare options, help for mentally ill residents to manage day-to-day needs, collaboration with families to determine the appropriate level of care for seniors, door-to-door resident visits and assessments, evaluation of seniors for dementia, help in obtaining in-home assistance and parental assistance. Their Emergency Assistance services include caregiver registries, adult day care, healthcare providers, hospice care and rehabilitation programs. Along with these options, other services include senior services and united outreach.

SERVICES: These communities benefit from a 'Life Plan' which includes: home care, personal emergency response systems, respite care, care coordination, skilled nursing, rehabilitation services, continuing care at home, hospice and all-inclusive care for the elderly.

SERVICES: Services include home and community services, residential healthcare, behavioral health services, community medical services, memory care, skilled nursing and other non-medical related services.

PSSS encourages older people to lead independent, fulfilling and enriched lives through intellectual and cultural activities and by providing social and healthcare services.

LOCATIONS: PSSS was established explicitly for the residents of Penn South Cooperative in New York

SERVICES: Care planning for in-home care, service coordination with agencies, care monitoring, healthcare management, healthcare assistance, health promotion, health screenings and vaccinations are among the top services provided residents.

To improve the health of the communities and patients they serve, the Community Outreach Program is fulfilling its responsibilities and commitment by providing healthcare services to income-restricted residents in Baltimore, MD.

LOCATIONS: An assigned Nurse Practitioner (NP) provides education and primary care services to residents of low-income senior independent living communities in the Towson, MD area. The NP goes to five housing communities once a week, including the Catholic Charities' Trinity House.

SERVICES: Residents receive glucose and blood pressure monitoring, as well as education and clarification on medications. Patients are also seen for acute illnesses and the NP coordinates with primary care physicians and specialists.

RHWP includes faculty and students from the Schools of Medicine, Nursing, Pharmacy, Social Work, Gerontology and the Department of Psychology, all of whom participate in weekly clinics conducted in Project-Based Sec. 8 Rental Assistance housing in Richmond, VA.

LOCATIONS: Weekly clinics are conducted at Dominion Place, a 249-unit affordable senior housing community in Richmond, VA.

SERVICES: Thanks to an interdisciplinary team, residents benefit from care coordination, chronic disease monitoring, blood pressure and glucose monitoring, wellness education that can augment a resident's healthcare and the prospect of maintaining health between doctor's visits.

LOCATIONS: CareOregon is partnering with Cedar Sinai Park in downtown Portland, OR to provide care to low-income senior residents.

SERVICES: The health and social services program is still developing, but currently offers post-acute care, convenient and flexible respite care, in-home care and varied social services to tenants.

Begun in 1888, Eliza Jennings Senior Care Network (Eliza Jennings) has been providing quality care to older adults on the West Side of Cleveland and Cuyahoga County, OH for almost 128 years. Eliza Jennings oversees a range of senior living communities that cover the complete continuum of today's residential long-term care needs.

LOCATIONS: Eliza Jennings operates wellness clinics in several affordable senior housing properties, but it approached the West-erly Apartments, in Lakewood, OH, to collaborate on an aging in place initiative for its residents.

SERVICES: Initially providing only outpatient physical and occupational therapy, Eliza Jennings now offers continuing support (transitional care) for residents returning home from the hospital or that require skilled nursing, health assessments, visits from social workers and home health aides, disease and medicine management, respite care and rehabilitation as part of their home and community-based services.
